Languages for Life Programmes: These long term courses allow students to focus on all aspects of the language over several months.

In-depth study over an extended period ensures better mastery, subtler understanding and far greater long term retention of key language skills. They are very popular with Gap Year students prior to University, graduates and adults looking to take a career break.

Standard Programme: Ideal for all age groups (18 yrs +) and all ability levels.

Combined Programme: 20 + 10 = 20 group lessons plus 10 private tuition lessons per week

Perfect for students and adults looking for the camaraderie of the group programme and the personal attention of private one-to-one lessons.

Standard + Arts Programme: Spanish lessons, cultural lessons and 10 arts & crafts lessons per week. Professional instructors, use of workshop facilities and tools, visits to traditional and contemporary artists & local craft markets. Materials are not included in the price, a list will be provided on the first day of class.

Volunteer Programme: Students aged 18yrs+, with good A/level (A2 UK standard) ability are able to participate in various volunteer capacities.

Teach English to Ecuadorian children, assist with child-care or senior citizens on a daily basis, help the homeless or serve as tour guides in the National Parks and Reserves. Many volunteer options can be combined with on going language training. A minimum commitment of four weeks language study/volunteering is required. Placement cost: **£97.00** (in addition to the cost of the language course and accommodation).

Private Tuition: 20/40 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity.

Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills.

LINK Programme: Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

Accommodation notes Accommodation proximity to college: Generally no more than 30 minutes on foot.

Private households, staying with Ecuadorian hosts, generally 10 to 30 mins commute from college. Single rooms or shared rooms (for friends/ couples ONLY), with half-board (breakfast & dinner). A good opportunity to practise Spanish out of class and experience Ecuadorian culture firsthand.

Studio apartments: Self contained studios, 2 beds, small living room, fully equipped bathroom, kitchenette and phone.

Minimum rental is 2 weeks.

2* Hotel: Just 12 minutes walk from the college. A restored colonial house with internal patios, with restaurant service and cafeteria. B&B basis. All rooms have en suite bathrooms and cable TV.
