Based on a modern, communicative style of teaching, students are able to improve their abilities in understanding and expressing colloquial and formal written grammar of the French language.
	Intensive programmes consist of 20 Standard group lessons plus a further 6 small group classes per week. Building on the lessons learnt in the Standard programme, additional practical French speaking exercises are utilised to encourage/enable students to acquire greater confidence in automatic reflexes in oral expression and improve pronunciation.
