Prices for supplementary courses are in addition to the Standard Programme courses quoted above.

Mini Group Programme: Ideal for all dedicated language learners (18 yrs+) and all ability levels. Lessons can be held in the morning or afternoon, the student can choose when enrolling. A highly interactive course with a strong emphasis on communication. Aims: to develop confidence in speaking; improve listening, speaking, reading and writing and to develop communication in everyday situations. The mini-group environment of 3/6 students ensures rapid language skill acquisition and plenty of student/teacher interaction. Aimed at adult students, predominantly professionals (and their spouses) plus older students passionate about French culture and younger students preparing for academic exams who are highly self motivated.

Beginners on this course MUST attend for a minimum TWO week course duration (all other levels can attend from ONE week plus).

Intensive Mini Group Programme: 15 group lessons plus a further 15 additional classes per week.

Almost all of these students are professionals (and their spouses) looking to intensively improve on their French language communication skills. This course is NOT open to beginners. If a group of 3 students cannot be formed at a particular level in the PM, the 15 PM lessons are converted into 6 hours of 1:1 private tuition or 10 lessons of 2:1 lessons.

Combined Programme: 15 + 5, 10 or 15= 15 group lessons plus additional private lessons per week.

Perfect for students and adults looking for the camaraderie of the group programme and the personal attention of private one-to-one lessons. Very popular with adult students (all ability levels) looking for a truly intensive programme.

Specialist Combined Programme: A combined programme with private tuition lessons tailored towards a specialist area of French, e.g. Oil Industry, French Tourism, Legal French, Medical French and Business French. Students need an Intermediate French level to benefit from this course and to develop technical language skills.

Business French Programme: A specialised one week programme aimed exclusively at business people with upper intermediate or advanced French who wish to enhance their understanding of the professional/ working environment in France.

Learn to communicate in a variety of business situations: telephone, emails, introducing a company, speaking in public, expressing agreement/disagreement during meetings, written correspondence.

also develop the vocabulary related to the business world: economical and banking environments of a firm, sales, marketing, finance management, human resources.

The course is tailored to the group's common objectives and needs. Students can then work on their individual needs during a one-to-one session on Thursday and Friday afternoon. Please ask for the "Paris One/Business Group Factsheet" for further information.

Teachers Refresher Programme: Advanced level students only. Ideal for those who wish to develop their skills with their peers. Teacher Training, revitalizing linguistic and didactic abilities in combination with advanced general language revision.

Private Tuition: 10/15/20/25/30 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity. Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs, level and availability to cover a variety of topics i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills.

A one to three week plus, concentrated private tuition course can reap excellent results for those who prefer not to join a mini-group course and wish to concentrate on their individual needs at their own pace.

Weekend Private Tuition: A 2 day programme (Saturday & Sunday) of intensive private tuition. Students are expected to arrive on Friday night (ready for early Saturday lessons) and depart on Sunday after the final lessons are completed.

Ideal for business people looking to refresh their skills who cannot spare a working week. Includes two lunches with the teacher.

Two teachers work alternately (one in AM, one in PM) adapting the course to the student's level and objectives. The course can cover either General French or Specialised French needs (if the student is Intermediate level+).

Specialised French areas covered to date include: Business French, French for Banking & Insurance, Legal French, French for the Hotel/Tourist Industry, Medical French, French for the Petroleum Industry.

Supplementary Programmes to the French language courses:

* Ritz Cookery Demonstration: A formal lecture based workshop on the art of French cooking

All of the course sessions shown below require a minimum of 3 people to proceed:

* Cookery in the Home: A more hands on session, ideal for foodie lovers everywhere.

* Wine Tasting Programme: An initiation into Oenology - students learn how to inspect, smell and taste different wines.

* 2 Hr Excursion with Tutor in PM : A chance to get out of the classroom and see the sights with a knowledgeable guide.

* Cookery with a chef and tasting:

* Savoire Faire PM Workshop: Again for Intermediate/advanced students. This session explains the etiquette of the French social scene, behaviour when out to dinner, how to avoid a social faux-pas, the fact and fiction of French gallantry!

LINK Programme. Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

Private Household: single room or shared room (for couples or friends only). Bed & breakfast or half-board (breakfast and evening meal basis).

Approximate distance from college: Varies, but allow for 25/40 mins one way by bus/metro and foot.
