 Course notes: **Academic Year & Languages for Life Programme:** These long term courses allow students to focus on all aspects of the language over several months. In-depth study over an extended period ensures better mastery, subtler understanding and far greater long term retention of key language skills. They are very popular with Gap Year students prior to University, graduates and adults looking to take a career break.

Standard Programme: Ideal for all age groups (recommended for 16 yrs +) and all ability levels.
 We recommend students follow this course for four weeks or longer to gain the maximum benefit, however shorter courses of one week plus duration are also productive for those already studying the language in their home country.
 The primary objective is to develop an individual's learning strategies. This enables the students to transfer communication skills already mastered in the native language to the new language. Verbal communication is a priority: learning to listen and understand, to express oneself correctly and with good pronunciation. The final objective is to raise students' language level to an efficient standard of communication. This requires not only a perfect command of the language but also a profound understanding of the cultural context.

Intensive Programmes: Building on the Standard programme and reinforcing language skills learnt in a further 10 group lessons per week.

Combined Programme: 20 + 5 or 10 = 20 group lessons plus additional private lessons per week.
 Perfect for students and adults looking for the camaraderie of the group programme and the personal attention of private one-to-one lessons.

Private Tuition: 10/20/30 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity. Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills. 45 mins per private lesson.

LINK Programme: Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

With good metro connections to the city centre and college.
