

These options are available, according to your level of ability and interests.

Combined Programme: 20 + 5 or 10 = 20 group lessons plus additional private lessons per week.

Perfect for students and adults looking for the camaraderie of the group programme and the personal attention of private one-to-one lessons.

Summer Campus Programmes:

Students can follow the Standard Group course/Option A (20 hours a week) or a less intensive/Option B (15 hours a week) group course in the South of Paris, near the Aquapark and the Porte de Versailles. Students live with locally based hosts (see host costs quoted above).

Additional Workshop options relating to DELF, French for Beginners etc. (as listed above) also available on request.

French & Fun/Paris: Open to 13/17yr old students ONLY. An all inclusive residential campus programme in the south of Paris. Tuition, activities and full board included. Please ask for the French & Fun/Paris factsheet for further information. Two way transfers for Teenage course : £63.00 if on set arrival/departure dates.

Specialised Programmes:

Business French course = Combine the Standard Group programme with PM Mini Group classes (max 3 students). 12 additional PM lessons per week. A one week programme (two week courses possible: 9 Jun., 15 Sept 2008).

French & Law = 20 group lessons per week and a French & Law PM workshop in Week One followed by visits to Court, meetings with professionals, lawyers and politicians.

French & Economics = 20 group lessons + PM workshops in week one and immersion in the French Business World in week two (meetings with Paris based professionals and visits).

French for Teachers = 21 group lessons per week. Morning programme plus 2 cultural activity afternoons per week. Offered on set dates, exclusively to Teachers or Trainee teachers of French as a foreign language.

Teachers can enrol on one, two or three additional afternoon sessions in the week, at extra cost, on request.

Course goals: a/ Learn or enhance knowledge of teaching/learning techniques of French as a foreign language /second language

b/ Develop teaching skills and classroom practices in interactive communicative situations

c/ Help learners to develop their creativity and intellectual abilities

d/ Look at different areas such as motivation, learning styles, etc

e/ Reflect on different teaching experiences and meet specialists (trainers, course designers, editors...)

Private Tuition: 10/15/20/25/30 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity.

Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills. 45 mins per private lesson.

LINK Programme: Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

Private households: Hosts offer B&B or 1/2 board and single or shared rooms. Shared rooms only recommended if 2 students are travelling together.

Allow for a commute of 20 to 40 mins, each way, occasionally longer still.

4* Host option: 17th c. private house, a real 'suite' with bedroom, en suite bathroom and living room. B&B or 1/2 brd.

Car parking place in the private garage (on request). For adult students only. Advanced request essential.

Residences: Only available for short term rental, with advanced notice essential, especially in the summer.

Residence 1: Distance from college, approx 40 mins one way commute 1/2 brd = breakfast & dinner.

Residence 2: Distance from college, approx 30 mins one way commute 1/2 brd = breakfast & dinner.

Both residences offer well priced, simple single rooms and facilities include a cafeteria, self-service restaurant & TV room.

With good metro connections to the city centre and college. NB: The residences are open to the public, not solely used by the college.

Summer Residence: University residence (in the 14th), room rental available for July & August only. Room with no breakfast and no meals.

Single room basis, with free wifi. Meals can be purchased in the on site cafeteria.

Long term Residence: Offered on a year round basis, for long term lets (5 weeks plus ONLY). Studios with TV, private bathroom, toilets, telephone and kitchenette. Additional fee for electricity charges (allow approx. 30 Euros per month) to be paid at the end of the stay.

Allow around 20/25 minutes commute by metro, each way to the college.

French & Fun/Paris Campus: Only open 30 June to 23 August 2008. Very popular with teenagers (13/17 yrs). Lessons held on site. Will become fully booked.

Located in the south of Paris, within easy reach of the Aquaboulevard (swimming pool and water leisure centre).

All rooms have a bed, table, chair and small wardrobe and sink per person. Communal showers, WC's on each floor. Linen provided.

Towels are not provided. There is a cafeteria, self-service restaurant, TV area and student common room, large terraces and a fitness centre on site.

NB: For all residences, please be aware that **early reservations are ESSENTIAL**, places become quickly booked up particularly during the June/September period.

Long Term Residence: Around 25 mins commute by public transport from college, there are 80, 20 sqm studios with TV, telephone,

en-suite bathroom, WC, sofa-bed, kitchenette. In 19th arrondissement. One person/per studio. Minimal rental 5 weeks duration.

Electricity : Deposit of 20 Euros requested on arrival + budget for monthly charge of approx. 25 Euros.

Credit card details required on arrival (against damages, security deposit).

Hotels: 2* Hotels from 75 Euros per night, 3* Hotels from 100 Euros per night. Please specify the style of Hotel and type of room required when enrolling.
