Course notes	<b>Academic Term Programmes:</b> These long term courses allow students to focus on all aspects of the language over several months. In-depth study over an extended period ensures better mastery, subtler understanding and far greater long term retention of key language skills. They are very popular with Gap Year students prior to University, graduates and adults looking to take a career break. Students can choose to follow a 20 or 30 lesson per week course, depending on the required intensity of study required. The 30 lessons per week course consists of 20 standard lessons plus 10 further small group classes, per week. <b>Standard Programme:</b> Ideal for all age groups (17 yrs +) and all ability levels. Short term programmes of one to seven weeks perfect for those already studying German, or who wish to get a feel for studying the language abroad, without making a long term commitment. <b>Intensive Programme:</b> As Standard Programme, but with additional lessons to further enhance the learning process in a smaller group environment. <b>Combined Programme:</b> 20 + 10 (or + 20) = 20 group lessons plus 10 or 20 private tuition lessons per week Perfect for students and adults looking for the camaraderie of the group programme and the personal attention of private one-to-one lessons. <b>Business German:</b> Cover general language topics and prepare yourself for the everyday communication needs of the modern working environment. <b>Work Experience Programme:</b> Internships can be arranged for students with a GOOD prior level of German. Students must follow a minimum 4 weeks language course (or 6, 8, 12, 16+weeks) prior to a placement of 6, 8 or 12 weeks duration. <b>Private Tuition:</b> 20/30 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity. Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills. <b>LINK Programme:</b> Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college

on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

**On Campus Studios:** **Very high demand last year, so please book early!** Maisonette style, (living area on first floor with sleeping area on 2nd floor) ensuite bathroom with shower & WC, satellite TV, phone & kitchenette. Just across the college private grounds from the classrooms, so no being late for class! Meals can be booked on a B&B, half-board or full-board basis, as preferred.

**Higher Standard On Campus Studios:** Offering the same facilities as above, with more spacious rooms and in-room internet access.

**Private household:** Students choose from half-board (breakfast and evening meal) or B&B accommodation (B&B students are welcome to use the kitchen to self cater). Allow for a one way commute to college of approx. 20/40 mins).

**Shared apartments:** For those who wish to live with German people, but prefer the independence of self-catering, this option delivers the best of both worlds. Allow for an approx. 20/40 min commute to college).
