Course notes

Languages for Life and Intensive Languages for Life: These long term courses allow students to focus on all aspects of the language over several months. In-depth study over an extended period ensures better mastery, subtler understanding and far greater long term retention of key language skills. They are very popular with Gap Year students prior to University, graduates and adults looking to take a career break. Basic programme option of 20 lessons per week or Plus programme with an additional 5 PM lessons per week (25 lessons/pr wk in total).

Standard & Intensive Programmes: Ideal for all age groups (17 yrs +) and all ability levels. Perfect for students already studying German or those who have limited time available. **One week "Standard" courses are ONLY available outside of the summer period.** Please note beginners must always respect the start dates shown in red.

Combined Programme: 25 or 20 group lessons plus either 5 or 10 private lessons, available all year round. One week course options only possible for 25 group lesson option (outside the summer period). Perfect for students and adults looking for the camaraderie of the group programme and the personal attention of private one-to-one lessons.

Work Experience Programme: Min. 8 wks language course plus local work placement (min 8 wks placement). Good level of German essential (B1+ on European language scale).

Teenage Programme: Tuition & accommodation, full board, shared room in host family included in fees. Also includes 2 day trip to Munich, a full day excursion at weekend, 1/2 day trip per week and daily social programme. Transfers are an additional cost. Please refer to the **German & Fun** information for full details.

Private Tuition: 20/25/30 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity. Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills.

LINK Programme: Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

Student Apartments: Simple accommodation for up to around 8 students per apartment, bedrooms for one or two students, communal kitchen and bathroom within easy walk of the college. Best suited to younger students (18/30 yrs) or those who are prepared for basic standard facilities (one on the island, the other, just on the mainland).

Private households: They are located on the mainland, just a short walk, bus or bike journey to the college. Share with local German hosts on either a single or shared room basis with half-board (breakfast and evening meal).

Local Hotel: A comfortable, small local Hotel is the ideal solution for older students requiring a few more creature comforts.
