Standard Programme: Ideal for all age groups (16 yrs +) and all ability levels.

A solid grounding in general Greek communication skills, pertinent to your language level, is provided over these two or four week sessions.

Students are welcome to enrol for two or more sessions, as time permits. Please note that if there are insufficient students to form a class level then the college will offer a reduced number of private language classes for that week or session, as appropriate.

Option for self-access study with CD-ROMs in the computer lab or watching a video in college (up to 6 lesson duration per week).

The course includes one traditional meal in a local Greek restaurant and one museum trip during the course.

Part time Programme: A less intensive option ideal for those who are living out in Greece already.

Offered as a 3 lessons per afternoon course, three times a week for an 8 week period.

Summer Term Course: A special 12 week course, allowing students to really gain a deeper knowledge of the language and gain a wider personal and educational experience of the Greek culture, over the popular summer period.

With all the benefits of the Standard Programme over a set, longer term format.

Private Tuition: 10/20/30 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity.

Lessons are tailored to meet your general language needs.

Specialised Private Tuition: The ideal course option for people with specific requirements to study Greek for business purposes, Ancient Greek for academic purposes or Teacher Training courses.

LINK Programme: Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

Accommodation notes

Private household: Single room and breakfast only basis.

Accommodation proximity to college: Based in the suburbs, but within easy access to the city centre and the college.

Students travel by bus each day.

Shared apartments: For 18yr olds+ only. Self catering basis. Within approximately 5 minutes commute of the college.

Hotels: Hotel One, located in central Athens has rooms with bath or shower, telephone, music and a balcony. It is fully air conditioned and facilities include a restaurant, bar, coffee shop and is just 5/10 mins walk from the college.

Hotel Option Two is centrally located, fully air conditioned with 100+ rooms with private bath, phone, music and TV.

Facilities include a small restaurant and bar (it is 10/15 mins walk from the college).
