Course notes	+ 10 = 10 private lessons (1:1) in addition to main language lessons Standard Programme: Ideal for all age groups (18 yrs +) and all ability levels. Hours: 8 am – 10 am and 10:30 – 12 noon with a break from 10 am to 10:30. In November, January and February, this programme is sometimes taught in the afternoon as well. Regardless of the level of the group, the focus of instruction is on improving oral competence and comprehension as well as writing. Communication : Small groups of seven participants maximum (five on average) create an amicable and lively atmosphere in which students can speak freely, take active part in group activities, and benefit from the teacher's personal attention with respect to special points of grammar or pronunciation. Construction : Problem-solving, role-playing, recreational activities, improvisation and simulation are an integral part of the course, enabling students to strengthen their active competence at their own pace and in keeping with their personal interests. Comprehension : A balanced combination of exercises, grammar and creative activities helps students better understand the function of language as a system and tool of cultural expression. Comprehension leads to greater competence. Each course level offered focuses on the efficient acquisition of communicative competence by the student: oral and written comprehension as well as oral expression, all of it underpinned by a systematic study of grammar. Written expression is more likely to be taught in afternoon sessions or private courses at the request of the student. The materials and methods used to teach various linguistic and cultural competences include authentic texts, documents developed by our teachers, role-playing, creative and recreational activities, and problem-solving (such as collecting information on market conditions, drawing up portraits of retailers, taking surveys, gathering information about various municipal administrations, etc.) Intensive Programme: 20 Standard group lessons plus a further 10 group lessons. 12:30 pm – 2:30 pm, for a total of 30 units per week. It is especially recommended to students seeking to perfect their conversational skills. While the maximum number of students per class is seven, the average class size is three or four, creating ideal conditions for discussing selected themes for which the vocabulary has been studied in advance.

Combined Programme: 20 Standard group lessons plus an additional 10 private lessons per week
 Private classes, in combination with the Standard programme, are designed for students who want to devote special attention to a particular point of grammar; to written French; to a specific objective in learning French (business, tourism, banking, law, literature); or to preparation for such examinations as DELF or DALF (NB : these exams can not yet be taken here in Guadeloupe).

Over 50 Programme: A great opportunity to study French with your peers for 20 lessons per week for two weeks. The course focuses on conversational skills, civilisation and cultural discovery. Students need to have an intermediate (B1+) French level to participate. Enjoy a full day trip to spectacular waterfalls, and half-day trips to a local distillery and a sugar factory. A cookery course and two lectures on Guadeloupian culture, ecology etc are also included.
 The course does not include the study of grammar in a systematic manner, the French language serving more as a practical tool to promote interaction and discovery. There is, however, a selective focus on vocabulary and grammar during the two weeks of the programme. The programme is held to coincide with three specific events during the year : carnival in February, the Drum Festival in July and All Saints' Day at the beginning of November.

TEF French Programme: The TEF exam proves a sound general French language ability. There are 10 group lessons (TEF preparation classes). The course cost covers lessons, TEF prep, TEF inscription and TEF exam fees.

French & Surf: Combine one week's French Standard group course with 5 afternoons of surf lessons on some of Guadeloupe's beautiful beaches! All equipment included. Each session is approx. 3 hrs duration.
 Accommodation is included. Students are based at Sunsetsurf Camp in rooms catering for three people (each room has its bathroom with shower, WC outside common for two rooms); American breakfast.
 Daily transfers from the Camp to the language college and back to the surf camp/ surf site inclusive.
 Arrival/departure transfers at Pointe à Pitre airport included as well.

French for Teachers: Two week courses offered twice in July. Exclusively aimed at teachers of French as a foreign language. This course of 2 x 30 units is designed for foreign teachers of French who are already working in their profession as well as for future teachers and is open to either individuals or closed groups. The workshop consists of classroom observation, discussion of teaching methods and grammatical explanations. The essential purpose of the workshop is to create teaching activities and build resources on documents based on selected elements of Creole and French cultures. These activities and documents are then tried out in the college classrooms.

French Volunteer Programme: Please ask for specific factsheet or view details on CESA website.

Private Tuition: 15/20/25 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity. Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills. **Not available during the summer session period.**

Private classes are designed for students who want to devote special attention to a particular point of grammar; to written French; to a specific objective in learning French (business, tourism, banking, law, literature); or to preparation for such examinations as DELF or DALF (NB : these exams can not yet be taken here in Guadeloupe).

DELF Programme: Private lessons offered on a weekly basis.
 Perfect for students and adults requiring private one-to-one lessons to perfect their language skills prior to sitting any of the four DELF exams. NB: It is not as yet possible to sit the exams themselves in Guadeloupe.

Creole Cooking: Students can book cookery lessons with a local professional cook in advance or once in St Anne's. Get a real taste for the Caribbean and book 15 lessons as PM classes!

LINK Programme: Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

Private households offer single rooms, on a breakfast only or breakfast and evening meal basis. Allow 15/25 mins for one way commute by bus or on foot. Shared room for couples or friends only.

Private household/studios have separate entrance and bathroom for privacy, single room, half board. Up to 25 mins from the college.

A: Simple studio apartments: basic kitchen facilities, no air con, up to 20 mins (1.5km) from college.

B: Studio apartments: with air con, balcony, TV, cooking facilities and garden view, closer to college, approx 5-20 mins walk.

C: Studio apartment/ Sea view: with air con, balcony, TV, cooking facilities and sea view, 5-20 mins from college or if close to Caravelle beach 20 mins from college.

All studios will require a deposit on arrival, allow for **150 Euros**.

Hotel: Excellent (simple) Hotel, on the beach, easy walk to college, with simply furnished, self contained studios or traditional rooms to let. 5 mins walk to college! Set in lovely tropical gardens. Very popular with past CESA clients, who prefer no commuting!
