Inclusive in course fees	Includes tuition, as offered, several activities such as a guided walking tour of Florence each month, an evening Italian workshop for those with queries, and an Italian video evening in the college each week.
Course notes	+ 5 = 5 private tuition lessons in addition to main language lessons in a week 20 / 4 = Standard Programme + 4 additional activity based sessions per week. Note: if there are less than 3 students per group level, group lessons will be replaced with a reduced number of one-to-one lessons. Languages for Life Programmes: These long term courses allow students to focus on all aspects of the language over several months. In-depth study over an extended period ensures better mastery, subtler understanding and far greater long term retention of key language skills. They are very popular with Gap Year students prior to University, graduates and adults looking to take a career break. Students can follow 20, 24 or 30 lessons per week. Standard Programme: Ideal for all age groups (17 yrs +) and all ability levels. Semi-Intensive Programme: As Standard Programme but with 04 additional lessons to enhance the learning process. Intensive Programme: As Standard Programme but with 10 additional lessons to further enhance the learning process. Combined Programmes: 20 + 5 (or 10) = 20 group lessons plus 5 (or 10) private tuition lessons per week Perfect for students and adults looking for the camaraderie of the group programme and the personal attention of private one-to-one lessons. Business Italian: The course develops active communication, both oral and written with reference to professional situations. An intermediate+ level is required. Aimed at those who need to perfect their Italian for business reasons. Offered as a stand alone programme OR in-conjunction with a Standard or Private tuition programme. Italian & Culture Programme: 20 Italian group lessons per week plus 4 additional lessons which enable students to explore both the history and culture of Italy, the language and its dialects, the pre and post war political system, society, classical and popular music, famous Italians of yesterday and today, the North/South conflict and the Mafia. Over 50's Programme: Aimed exclusively at older students, who already have elementary plus Italian and prefer to study with their peers:- Art History option: Combining 15 language lessons per week with 3 lectures on Renaissance Art and history & 3 guided visits viewing Renaissance monuments and museums. Contact CESA for exact schedule. Cookery option: Combining 15 language lessons per week with 2 lectures on Tuscan Cooking or Wine and 2 visits, to a famous food market and wine or oil cellar, a full day excursion to the Chianti region and a farewell dinner in a typical Florentine Trattoria. Private Tuition: 20/25/30 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity. Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs e.g. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills. Students can book 1:1 lessons or 2:1 lessons (if they are studying with a friend or family member at the same language level). LINK Programme: Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions! A shared room is <u>only</u> possible for students travelling together. Studio Residence: Nice, comfortable private studios with a bath, kitchenette, telephone, internet access, air conditioning and sat TV. Just 2 to 3 minutes

walk from the college. Studios are very popular and we recommend early reservations. This becomes essential during for the summer months.

**Private households:** Choose from a bed and breakfast or half-board option in either single room or shared room (if with a friend) with local hosts. All hosts are within walking or easy bus commute distance of the college.

**Shared apartments** are most likely to be with other students (although can be with local Italians). Students must anticipate being 15/30 mins away from the college. Students have access to a kitchen and shared bathroom. They are simple and clean. Telephones are unlikely to be available. Only available to students aged 18 yrs or above.

Allow between 30 / 85€ per 4 weeks to cover amenities (payable in Italy) and a damages deposit will also be required on arrival in €.

**Private apartments:** Fully furnished sole occupancy apartments for one or two people, generally let on a 4 week plus basis (2 or 3 wks sometimes possible). Utilities at extra cost - allow for 50€ per 4 wks. € deposit required.
