Ramadam: Classes are held, however no eating or drinking is allowed in the college in the hours of daylight. Dates affected by Ramadam: 1 Sept to 29 September in 2008. Programme dates are arranged so that lessons lost due to holidays are made up within the session timetable Holidays within sessions affected are: 10/11 Jan, 4/5 Feb, 1 May, 6 & 18 Nov & 11/12 Dec '08. On these dates no lessons will be held.

Books & Materials	MSA = Core text book for Intensive programmes: Al-Kitab fii Ta'allum al-'Arabiyya (for MSA 100 & 200 programmes = Vol. One & for MSA 300 & 400 = Vol. 2). Can be purchased in advance or once in Fez. CMA = All texts are produced by the college for student use.
Course notes	Programmes are divided into the six week Intensive sessions of 120 classroom lessons or in the case of the shorter Standard Programmes, three week sessions of 60 classroom lessons. All lessons are held in Arabic except for the most elementary courses but even then the use of English is kept to a minimum. MSA = the language of the Arabic news media, written correspondence and documents, literature and formal speech. CMA = the local Arabic dialect

Accommodation notes	College residence: A lovely villa near the school with a private garden and fabulous views of the old Medina of Fez, single or shared rooms with communal bathrooms and kitchen are offered. Room availability is limited. It is important to make your reservation as early as possible. This is particularly important during the busy summer period. It may be necessary to stay for the first few days (or the duration of a short course in a nearby Hotel). Kindly contact the CESA staff for full details. Private households: A fabulous experience and a real cultural insight but please note hosts are not "standardised". You are expected to participate in your hosts lives, not bend their ways to suit your own. If you feel that lack of privacy, unfamiliar meals, noise from a TV or the radio or lack of private study space would not suit you, this may not be the option for you. However the positive experience of living in the heart of a Moroccan household comes highly recommended for those who are willing to accept the limitations on personal freedom that comes with it. Local Hotels: You can choose to stay in a cheap, medium or good standard Hotel. CESA recommends a Hotel just opposite the college that costs approx. £22.00 per night for a single room. Private apartments: Luxury furnished apartments cost at least £500 per month. Cheaper apartments, always rented unfurnished can be found but are only worth renting by long term students (allow £200 a month + 2 months deposit). Not recommended for our Gap Year clients - the local Hotel or the residence are much more suitable options for younger students. Contact CESA if interested in taking an apartment.
