Academic Year & Languages for Life Programme: These long term courses allow students to focus on all aspects of the language over several months. In-depth study over an extended period ensures better mastery, subtler understanding and far greater long term retention of key language skills. They are very popular with Gap Year students prior to University, graduates and adults looking to take a career break.

Standard Programme: Ideal for all age groups (16 yrs +) and all ability levels.

The college's method places specific emphasis on language for communication. The method can be described as structural/functional, the grammar and structures being taught and learned naturally, through practical usage. Students are encouraged to use college audio, video and library facilities in order to practice language skills.

Group Courses are organised in modules of 4 weeks. Every month group classes start at all levels (from Beginner to Advanced). Courses are progressive from the starting dates, but apart from absolute beginners who must begin on the starting dates, students can join a group at any time if vacancies exist at the suitable level. Monitoring and assessment are continuous and personalised throughout your programme.

Intensive Programme: As Standard Programme, but with additional lessons to further enhance the learning process.

Combined Programme: 15 + 5 = 15 group lessons plus 5 private tuition lessons per week (or 10 or 15 PT lessons)

Perfect for students and adults looking for the camaraderie of the group programme and the personal attention of private one-to-one lessons.

Easter Programme: Set group programme, with a larger group size. Open to beginner/intermediate language levels.

Summer Programme: Set group programme, with a larger group size. Open to beginner/intermediate language levels.

Teacher Training Programme: 30 lessons per week with 10 participants. Ideal for those teachers who wish to extend and update their knowledge of language teaching. Offered twice a year.

Gastronomy: This course may be taken in-conjunction with a language course, and runs for three afternoons in the week. One afternoon for shopping in a traditional market, one afternoon to prepare ingredients in the schools kitchen, and the other afternoon to cook and have dinner in the school. Only possible when there is sufficient student interest.

Private Tuition: 10/15/20/25 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity.

Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills.

LINK Programme: Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

Accommodation notes

Private households: Stay with local hosts, single room, breakfast only (eating out is easy and cheap in Lisbon, hence students are only provided with breakfast by their hosts). Accommodation proximity to college: Typically 15/35 mins by bus from college
Long term students can request kitchen access for self catering (depending on suitable host availability). Please confirm this requirement to CESA well in advance of course start date.
