



**DELE Preparation:** Preparation for the exams held in May & November each year. Students need to enrol for the exam in April (for May exams) & October (for November exams) with an extra date only for students in Spain in August.

**Spanish & Skiing:** Combining one week of Spanish language study (20 or 30 group lesson) with one week of skiing in the Sierra Nevada mountains accompanied by a Spanish teacher. Includes a 5 day lift pass. If the ski-centre is closed or there is no access to it, Spanish lessons will be held in lieu. When skiing, transport is arranged to/from the slopes. Lessons with a ski instructor can be arranged at additional cost. Ski equipment can be hired (at extra cost). If you've booked private household/full board accommodation, the hosts will provide a picnic lunch for the slopes. Additional language course weeks can be booked prior to/ or post skiing week as required. No more than 2 weeks skiing can be booked with any length of language course.

Quotes above break down as: 2 wks price = 1 wk Spanish + 1 wk Skiing. 3 wks price = 2 wks Spanish + 1 wk Skiing.

4 wks price = 2 wks Spanish + 2 wks Skiing.

**Spanish & Horse Riding:** Combine your half-day Spanish studies with horse riding lessons & 8 sessions per week = 2 hour sessions on Tuesday, Wednesday & 1st Thursday, and 2 hour sessions on 2nd Tuesday/Wednesday & 4 hour sessions on 2nd Thursday, though some sessions may be transferred to Saturday morning). Horse Riding content: Beginner/intermediate levels: prep and saddling the horse, training in the paddock, position, equilibrium and horse control, adjustment of stirrups etc, walking and riding in the open field and basic difference between classic and cowboy riding. Expert level: Mountain excursion & training in open field and paddock work.

**Private Tuition:** 20/25/30 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity.

Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills.

**LINK Programme:** Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

**Private households:** single or shared room accommodation with local Spanish people, on half or full board basis. Allow for a 10/25 minute commute each way. Good opportunity to practise your language skills with native speakers.

Half board accommodation = breakfast and lunch.

**Shared apartments:** Sharing with international students, communal kitchen & bathroom and own bedroom. Simply furnished.

Popular with students who prefer greater independence. Accommodation proximity to college: Typically 15/20 mins by foot from college
