**Languages for Life Programme:** These long term courses allow students to focus on all aspects of the language over several months. In-depth study over an extended period ensures better mastery, subtler understanding and far greater long term retention of key language skills. They are very popular with Gap Year students prior to University, graduates and adults looking to take a career break.

**Academic Year Programme:** With a minimum 24 week course duration, these programmes allow students to gain a deep knowledge of the language and gain a wide personal and educational experience of the Spanish culture.

**Standard Programme:** Ideal for all age groups (16 yrs +) and all ability levels.

**Intensive Programme:** As Standard Programme, but with additional lessons to further enhance the learning process.

**Combined Programme:** 20 + 10 = 20 group lessons plus 10 private tuition lessons per week  
Perfect for students and adults looking for the camaraderie of the group programme and the personal attention of private one-to-one lessons.

**DELE Programme:** Preparing for the exams in May, August and November each year, exact dates known from Jan each year.  
DELE preparation = 4 or 5 week + programme.

**Spanish plus History:** 10 Spanish lessons, 10 lessons devoted to History and 5 cultural lessons per week.  
History of Spain: the influences of the Romans, Arabic and Hebrew civilizations, the impact of the unification of Spain and the history of the Hapsburg & Bourbon dynasties.

**Spanish plus Art History:** 10 Spanish lessons, 10 lessons devoted to Art History and 5 cultural lessons per week.

Spanish art is considered in terms of the Roman, Moorish Renaissance & Baroque periods and masters such as Goya, Velazquez, Picasso, Miro & Dali are explored.

**Spanish & Literature:** 10 Spanish lessons, 10 literature lessons and 5 cultural lessons per week.

The genres of outstanding Hispanic writers and significant trends in Spanish & Latin America literature are examined - the Golden Age, Romanticism, Generation of 1927, the Contemporary Novel, Cervantes, Lorca, Cela, Garcia Marquez, Isabel Allende, Borges & Carlos Fuentes.

**Business Spanish:** Aimed exclusively at intermediate plus ability levels it is an ideal programme for business people or students who wish to improve their Spanish for the working environment; 20 lessons of Spanish business study and 5 cultural lessons per week (in blocks of 2 or 4 weeks). Specialised subjects proposed include: business companies structure & financial management in Spain & Latin America, commercial relationships, banks, financial operations & UE financial institutions, marketing and advertising, international trade, the stock market, the tourism market, the Spanish labour market, tax legislation & Spain and the European Union.

**Teacher Training Programme:** 30 lessons per week with 10/25 participants. Ideal for those teachers who wish to extend and update their knowledge of language teaching.

**Spanish & Flamenco:** 20 Spanish lessons and 8 dance classes Monday/Friday. The Flamenco classes are held in one of the oldest and best known Flamenco schools in the afternoons or evenings.

**Private Tuition:** 5/30 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity.

Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills. **NB:** Specific business, professional or technical language lessons incur an additional 20% supplement.

**LINK Programme:** Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

**Private households:** single or shared room accommodation with local Spanish people, on half or full board basis. Allow for a 15/30 minute commute each way. Good opportunity to practise your language skills with native speakers.

**Student residence:** Sharing with other international or Spanish students, communal bathroom and own bedroom. Small residences offering catering or larger Uni dorm style residences offered. Typically 15 mins by bus from college. Particularly popular with younger students, good sociable atmosphere. Offered on half or full board basis.

**Shared apartments:** Sharing with international or Spanish students, communal kitchen & bathroom and own bedroom. Simply furnished. Popular with students who prefer greater independence. Accommodation proximity to college: Typically 15/25 mins by bus from college
