

Combined Programme: 20 + 10 = 20 mini group lessons plus 10 private tuition lessons per week

Perfect for students and adults looking for the camaraderie of the group programme and the personal attention of private one-to-one lessons. Perfect for combining the experience of learning Spanish language in a mini group whilst at the same time receiving private classes. The courses in the morning help with student interaction and aid students to improve their speaking skills. The private classes allow students to cover areas that need extra practice with their teacher or study topics that interest them especially.

The students who normally study in this type of Spanish course are generally highly motivated to learn as much Spanish as they can in the shortest time possible. Only recommended for highly motivated students.

Spanish & Flamenco: A combination of morning lessons and flamenco lessons for one hour in the afternoon from Monday to Thursday. Flamenco lessons will be reduced if there are only a few students.

The Flamenco school used, is situated in the centre of Seville. The teacher was born in Seville and she opened her own school after many years of experience in and study of Dance. It is recognised as one of the most prestigious schools in the city. The language college works with this Flamenco school in order to offer Intensive Spanish and Flamenco courses and Intensive Spanish and Sevillanas course. In addition to a Standard Spanish group programme, students study (one hour daily) of Flamenco or Sevillanas (dance / guitar), Monday to Thursday, for a two weeks course duration. NB: If there are less than four students for this course, Flamenco class hours will be reduced or changed to reflect the actual student numbers enrolled.

Over 50 Programme: Aimed at those older students who wish to study with their peers, emphasis is on oral expressions, social and cultural aspects rather than grammar analysis and written skills. Four cultural activities are offered a week, visits to museums and monuments, a show, a meal with a teacher and a Saturday excursion. Third week extension is tuition only in Standard programme with no inclusive activities.

The teachers who impart this two week course are conscious of the specific needs of these students as well as their different rhythm of learning and the importance of special emphasis on the culture (festivals and traditions, history and literature and the way of life, as well as avoiding misunderstandings).

Teenage Programme: A great combination of morning lessons aimed specifically at teenagers and free time activities, such as workshops on Spanish customs, a party with young Spanish people (who study at the school), weekend excursions, visits to places of interest, dance classes and a cookery programme. Fees includes tuition and accommodation (private household or residence, shared rm, full board), social programmes, 2 way transfers from Seville airport. For further details please contact CESA.

Private Tuition: 20/30 private one-to-one lessons per week with private tutors. Maximum impact and course intensity. Lessons are tailored to meet your specific needs i.e. preparation prior to exams, practise prior to a business presentation or a new job, or concentration on communication skills.

DELE Programme: Preparing for the exams in May and November each year, exact dates known from Jan 08

Includes 20 general and 6 or 10 DELE specific preparation lessons per week. For Intermediate and Advanced levels ONLY. Exam fees not included.

In Seville the FEDELE Sevilla member schools prepare students for the exam on the three existing levels "Inicial, Intermedio and Superior" and handle all the inscription formalities for the candidates. Our school is a member of FEDELE.

In order to sit the exams, students must have a Intermediate level (B1) for the Initial Diploma, for the Intermedio they should be at least Advanced level (B2), and students wishing to sit the Superior level should have an Proficiency level (C2) of Spanish at the beginning of the course. Students will attend morning classes on our General Intensive course and in the afternoon will receive 6 additional classes of specific exam preparation.

The DELE exams are held in Seville at the same time as they are held in 18 other Spanish cities and more than 100 centres abroad in May, November and also in August. Exact dates are confirmed ONLY in January each year.

MCCI Business Spanish: A 4 week preparation course leading directly to the MCCI Spanish for Business purposes exams.

Intermediate Spanish essential. The course is made up of 20 general language classes & 2 cultural classes per week as well as 10 classes of Business Spanish in groups of 6 to 10 students. Topics included in this course are: business correspondence, verbal negotiation, socio-political geography, as well as the state of the Spanish economy in the Hispanic and International markets. It is an ideal course for professionals working in import-export or for those who wish to work in Andalusia.

Exam fee: 110 Euros (not paid via CESA).

Refresher for Teachers: An additional class, ideal for those who wish to develop their skills with their peers. Teacher Training, Spanish Culture and Methodology. If there are 2 or less students at a class level, PM classes will be reduced to 5 private lessons

Business Programmes: Aimed purely at those who wish to improve their Spanish for business purposes. Supplementary to the Standard course an extra 10 business Spanish lessons. If there are 2 or less students at a class level, PM classes will be reduced to 5 private lessons.

Conversation & Grammar: An extra class ideal for; those with specific weaknesses which they wish to explore in greater depth and those who wish to speed up the learning process so that they can reach a higher level as soon as possible.

Hispanic Studies: An extra class ideal for those who already have a good Spanish level and who wish to enrich their language studies. The course explores dialects, history of the language, contemporary literature and combines well with the Standard and Languages for Life programmes. Lessons will be reduced if there are only a few students.

Work Experience: Unpaid work experience often, but not exclusively in the hotel & restaurant sector. Students must enrol on a minimum of 2 or 4 weeks language course prior to work experience so the college can verify they have at least an Intermediate level in Spanish.

Students are welcome to book longer language programmes, to gain the relevant language ability before their work placement, but a placement is conditional on achieving intermediate Spanish ability.

The Spanish + work experience is intended to allow students from EU Countries to gain some work experience and at the same time, benefit from improving and practising the language in a professional environment.

In the last 5 years, the language college has developed a solid network of small and medium size companies which are keen to host foreign interns. In addition to developing language skills, The Spanish+Work experience formula offers the invaluable opportunity to: Become familiar with the Spanish professional environment and methodology and widen professional horizons - Develop specific language knowledge and skills related to specialised areas - Establish key contacts in Spain which will constitute a vital asset for professional future.

Two week intensive Spanish course followed by a 12 week internship or four week intensive Spanish course followed by a 12 week internship.

LINK Programme: Why not study in two or three locations? You can study for two weeks (or more) in each college on a LINK Programme. Please ask the CESA staff for suggestions!

Accommodation proximity to college: very rarely more than 20 minutes on foot, one way.

College Residences: There are a number of good, small residences on offer. They are all within easy walk of the college.

The student residences are located in the heart of the city with both single and double rooms available as well as shared living room, kitchen and bathroom. There are 6 to 15 students per residence. Higher standard rooms with en suite bathrooms are available at a higher charge.

En suite rooms particularly appeal to adult students, but are in short supply, so early bookings are recommended.

We recommend this option for those students who wish to be more independent and share an international environment together with their classmates of different nationalities. Cleaning included.

Private households: single or shared room accommodation with local Spanish people, on half or full board basis. Allow for a 10/20 minute commute each way. Good opportunity to practise your language skills with native speakers.

NB: Half board = Breakfast & lunch. Dinner is available on request, but the majority of students will book the breakfast/lunch option. If following a programme of 25 lessons or more (per week), discuss changing to breakfast and dinner with CESA as it may be easier for you.

Private household, on suite is in limited supply, so is reserved SOLELY for students on Over 50, Super Mini and Private tuition courses ONLY.

Flat share (with Spaniards): Popular option for those who prefer more independence but still want contact with Spanish people out of class. Self catering single or (in some cases) shared rooms on offer for students aged 18+.

Private standard and higher standard apartments: Sole occupancy of apartments in Seville can be arranged on request. Please provide as much notice as possible, to ensure availability. All flats are furnished and have a living room, fully equipped kitchen and bathroom.

The majority have one bedroom with twin beds or a double bed. This is a good choice for those that want to be totally independent or who come accompanied. There are also high standard flats available for a small supplement and all are located in the centre of Seville.

Cleaning service is not included.
