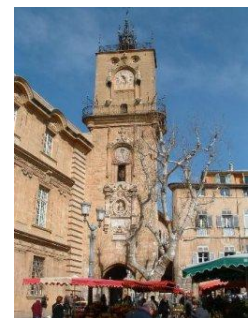

Start in the Cours Mirabeau (a street lined with cafes, restaurants and elegant mansions, and shaded by several rows of centuries-old plane trees) sit at one of the terraces and watch life go by while sipping a cappuccino or latte & listen to the water playing in nearby fountains ~ explore the Old Town to the north and the Quartier Mazarin to the south ~ must sees include the Musée Granet (great 17th c. painting collection), the Atelier Cézanne & the Fondation Vasarely.
