Benalmadena : Spanish for Teenagers

2012

13/17 yr olds

A charming Andalucian town, originally a fishing village, it is still a sea of white washed little houses with good shops, a wonderful marina and beaches just a short walk away. It is within easy reach by air from Malaga and greatly appeals to our younger students.



Standard Programme

- One, two, three, four, five or six week programmes
- 15 group lessons
- Up to 15 students per class
- 55 minutes per lesson
- Lessons run from the first Monday after assessment
- All levels catered for (beginner/advanced)

In total there are 30 lessons over 2 weeks (unless a day is lost to a public holiday, in which case a group excursion is arranged instead). This is equal to nearly a term of contact lessons at your school in the UK. Morning studies revolve around formal classroom study based on modern teaching methods combined with project work and various social activities to introduce the students to Spanish culture and lifestyle.

Lessons are held in a modern state school, just a short walk down hill to the beach and the shopping centre of Benalmadena.

Excursions:

A range of activities are offered (all accompanied/supervised by the monitors) as an inclusive part of this programme including 1/ Three afternoons of sports per week: badminton, football, basketball etc 2/ Dance classes: Sevillanas, Salsa and other Latino dances 3/ One half day excursion (Malaga, Marbella, Mijas & Nerja) and one full day excursion (Saturday trips - Granada, Seville, Cordoba or Ronda including entrance fees to any museums or monuments) per week 4/ Three evening activities per week: fancy dress parties, a trip to the cinema, bowling, to Tivoli World Amusement Park etc.

Accommodation:

With local hosts in private households in and around Benalmadena on a full-board basis. Lunches in the week are taken at the college or as picnics arranged by your hosts, if on a weekend excursion. The hosts are generally within a short walk from the college, but late enrolments may mean students can be up to 30 minutes commute, including a short train journey, from the college. Students are housed in shared rooms with another language student.

Travel directions:

Arrive: Sunday

Depart: Sunday AM

Fly to Malaga airport and take advantage of the inclusive transfer to Benalmadena.

Fees include: Tuition and accommodation for length of course booked, return transfer from Malaga airport on arrival Sunday and departure Sunday at agreed times only, social activities described as inclusive in course fees.

Going Out Permission:

For 16/17 year olds.

The college insists that students respect the following curfews as the LATEST hour by which they must return home: by 24.00hrs from Sunday to Thursday and 01.30hrs on Friday and Saturday.

For 13/15 year olds.

The college requires that all students stay in, with their hosts after dinner during the week (unless there is a specific school arranged activity that evening). Only at the weekend are students allowed out at night after dinner, and a curfew of Midnight is laid down.

Parents are asked to confirm their agreement to this arrangement and to ensure their child understands and agrees to abide by the curfew.

Course Enrolment

On receipt of your form we will enrol you on the course and send confirmation of your booking, an invoice, a college brochure and a Briefing Pack. It includes forms for parents/guardians to complete regarding travel, medical emergencies, going-out permission etc. These forms **must** be returned to us *before* the student leaves for Spain.
