Chania offers the perfect setting for language students who wish to explore Greek island life, whilst improving their Greek language skills. Chania is located in the west of Crete & is divided into two parts: The New Town which is where the day to day business goes on, with its shops and offices, the post office and banks, the renowned indoor market and the bus station, and the Old Town, built around the Venetian harbour with numerous picturesque narrow streets and architecture showing the influence of decades of foreign domination. The Old Town is also the centre of nightlife with many bars and clubs and where most students gravitate when not on the beach or in classes!

The school is housed in a comfortable, modern building (with air-con) and has four classrooms, a computer lab and a library. In addition, it is very close to Chania city's centre, the Venetian harbour and Nea Chora Beach. During summer, the course includes various social evenings to restaurants, excursions to the island's beaches and visits to some of the many archaeological sites of Crete.

The courses run throughout the year at all levels from beginners to advanced. Classes focus on the four main language skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing, combined with aspects of local culture. This course is recommended for those who wish to learn the language at a steady pace and attracts students of all ages and backgrounds.

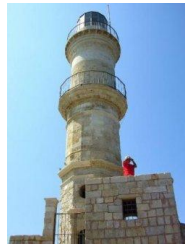
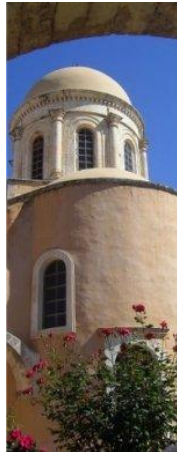
