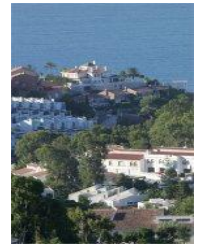

The programmes are ideal if you are plan to live part of the year in a different country or have a favourite holiday destination, or visit friends or family abroad.

Malaga

The school was established in 1971 and is located in a purpose built residence only 10 minutes walk downhill, to the main beach front area, with an amazing array of bars and restaurants to suit all pockets and appetites. It is also only 20 minutes by bus to the centre of Malaga city. Students love the local area, located up in the hills, amongst pleasant, low level villas with good local amenities and an easy stroll down to the beach.

The college facilities include 20 classrooms, most with a TV & video, a small cinema, private study area and a multi media centre with computer learning facilities. In addition the college has beautiful sun terraces, a restaurant and bar, a dance studio, a small pool and laundrette. The college residence is on site, which ensures that the social focal point for students is the sun terraces in all but the poorest of weathers! The college teachers are all native speakers of Spanish, with University degrees or comparable experience, who specialise in teaching Spanish as a second language.

Aimed at those older students who wish to study with their peers whilst concentrating on developing their communication skills and enjoying a varied social activity programme. Courses are aimed at three abilities; beginner, intermediate and advanced levels. Beginners concentrate on highly practical situations whilst more advanced students will discuss aspects of Spanish life, society, culture and politics. Activities may include shopping in the central market, a cookery or Sevillanas dance class, lunch with a teacher, a visit to the Alcazaba (castle) and the Cathedral or a trip to the botanical gardens. There will also be a full day Saturday excursion i.e. to Granada.

2 or 4 weeks language course duration

Open to 50 yrs + age group

Max. 10 people per class

15 group language lessons per week + activity programme

Levels: Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced

Timetable: Morning lessons plus a social programme

Accommodation: With local Spanish hosts or in the college residence (various room sizes are offered, CESA has quoted a small single en suite room, higher standard options are available)

Activities can include: tour of Malaga, visit to Central Market, visit to Botanical Gardens, Sevillanas class, cookery class, visit to Alcazaba castle, trip to Nerja/Frigiliana, flamenco party and excursion to Granada.

The college is located up a steep hill and there are number of steps from the pavement to climb. If you have any difficulties with walking, please discuss this with CESA before booking.





Nerja

The school was established in 1980 and is based in two adjacent, typical Andalucian houses, only 5 minutes walk from the centre of the old town. Students always enjoy the private garden with a sun terrace and patios for student use, both during and after classes.

There are 12 classrooms indoors, each with a TV, video and audio machines, however lessons are frequently held in the garden under the shade of the bougainvillea. The video-centre offers a wide choice of films for student use in the college, likewise the library offer a range of books for student use and the book shop offers a range of dictionaries, general reading matter and audio and video tapes for sale. The college also has a snack bar and offers the students email access on site.

The college becomes fully booked during August each year (so please book early if you wish to study in Nerja during the summer). The college teachers are all native speakers of Spanish, who specialise in teaching Spanish as a second language.

A programme designed for people with free time, ready to have a new experience in the south of Spain, in Andalusia, and to learn Spanish in an enjoyable and encouraging way. It is a short Spanish language course aimed at adults, over 50 years of age who wish to study with their peers in an informal atmosphere and enjoy the social programme offered (a full day excursion, Sevillanas dance classes, a visit to Frigiliana, wine tasting, a seminar on bull fighting, a cookery class and a Sevillanas dance show).

2 weeks language course duration

Levels: Beginner, Intermediate & Advanced

Timetable: Morning programme plus activities

Accommodation: With local Spanish hosts or in the college residence (or local Hotels)

Activities can include: talk on Flamenco dancing, wine tasting, salsa evening, talk on Bull fighting and an excursion to Malaga on Saturday.





Barcelona

The school was established in 1972 and is based in a well-appointed town house, with its own roof terrace, only a few minutes walk from the Plaza Catalunya and Las Ramblas. There are 35 air conditioned classrooms, with audio machines and access to TV and video, an internet room, library and study centre and student bar. The college becomes very busy during July and August each year (so please book early if you wish to study in Barcelona during the summer). The college teachers are all native speakers of Spanish, who specialise in teaching Spanish as a second language.

Additional Option: **Over 50s plus Creative Arts Workshop**

Same start dates as Barcelona Over 50s Course

Tuition: € 640.00 + CESA Fee : €40.00 + Host accommodation (quoted above)

4 workshops are scheduled to take place over the two weeks of your course, with two workshops per week, each lasting between 1 and 1.5 hours. All materials are provided and you are welcome to take home any work you produce.

~ **Painting Ceramics workshop**

This workshop consists of decorating a porcelain dragon figure (designed by Gaudi) which has previously been fired at 1200° C. The decorative mosaic technique often used by Gaudi is also explained in detail.

~ **Glass-fusing workshop**

Students will study the many marvellous possibilities of working with molten glass. Each participant will produce a plate or bowl and decorate it according to their own preferences.

~ **Pottery workshop**

Following a demonstration of the art of 'throwing' a pot on a wheel, each participant will be given the opportunity to produce a bowl, plate or jug of their own.

~ **Sculpture workshop**

This workshop focuses on how to make sculptures appear well balanced and less static than is often the case. Each participant will be then be given the opportunity to make a Picasso-style Spanish bull.

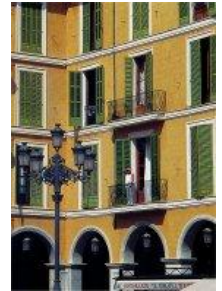


Palma de Mallorca

Set in a beautiful natural bay, Palma has been the capital of Mallorca for over 1000 years. Modern Palma is a bustling city with a population of just over 300,000. The city has an extraordinarily beautiful Gothic Quarter and many fine monuments and squares. The principle attraction is the golden toned cathedral, which was built over a 300-year period and still dominates the skyline overlooking the harbour.

The school occupies a large, elegant building in the very centre of the old city, on the Plaza de Cort, near the city hall. The school occupies all 4 floors of the building and has 20 air-conditioned classrooms, as well as a number of offices and a recreational area with several computers, which students are able to use either before or after class.

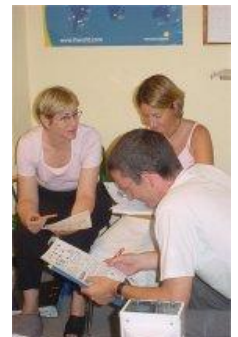

Seville

The school was established in 1983 and is located in a typically Andalucian town house with a beautiful central courtyard around which are 25 classrooms, an internet room, a library, a bookshop and study room. It is within easy reach of the Cathedral and the Royal Palaces by foot and is located in the heart of the old town.

The busiest study periods of the year occur during the long Spring and Autumn months. The staff are always on hand should you have any questions once on your course. The college teachers are all native speakers of Spanish, with University degrees, who specialise in teaching Spanish as a second language.

Aimed at those older students who wish to study with their peers whilst concentrating on developing their communication skills. The course focuses on the social and cultural aspects of the Spanish language rather than grammar analysis and written skills. It also includes four cultural activities per week; visits to museums and monuments, a show, an evening meal with a teacher and a Saturday excursion.

Classes are in small groups with the emphasis on oral expression, as well as social and cultural aspects rather than grammar analysis and written skills. The teachers who impart this course are conscious of the specific needs of the students as well as their different rhythm of learning and the importance of special emphasis on culture (festivals and traditions, history and literature and the Spanish life style).



Spanish for the Over 40s:

20 group language lessons per week plus 4 optional cultural lessons per week

Max. 8 people per class

Levels: Elementary to Upper Intermediate levels A1 to B2

Timetable: Morning timetable plus social programme

Accommodation: With local Spanish hosts, in College residence accommodation or can be arranged in local Hotels on request



The programme includes Seville airport or train station transfer upon arrival, 20 Spanish classes per week, welcome drink and cultural activities, four days a week. Entrance tickets to the museums and monuments are included as well as a concert or theatre evening, a meal with the teacher and a Saturday full day excursion.
